

BYLAW NO. 83/67

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BLAINE LAKE IN
THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO CHANGE
THE NAME OF A CERTAIN AVENUE IN THE
TOWN OF BLAINE LAKE

The Council of the Town of Blaine Lake, in the
Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows;

1. That the street shown as Avenue " C " shall have
its name changed and shall henceforth be known as " HORSESHOE
CRESCENT "

2. On the passing of this Bylaw all proper officers
of the Town shall take appropriate action to carry the said
changes into effect and have the registered plans affected
properly amended.

3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect
on the day of the final passing thereof.

Read a third time by unanimous vote of all members of
the Council present and finally passed this 14th day of February,
A.D. 1967.


