

BYLAW 98/71

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BLAINE LAKE TO AUTHORIZE CLOSURE OF PORTION
OF 4th AVENUE REGISTERED PLAN CU 1124

WHEREAS Section 160 of the Urban Municipality Act as enacted Chapter
78 of the Statutes of Saskatchewan of 1970 gives the Town Council powers
to closure of public highways.


AND WHEREAS it is expedient to make provisions for the exercise of the
said powers,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BLAINE LAKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the most southerly 14 feet in perpendicular width throughout
of Fourth Avenue Registered Plan No. CU 1124 in the Townsite of
Blaine Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan be closed and be
consolidated with Parcel C and Public Reserve R 3 Plan No. CU 1124.
2. That this bylaw shall come into effect upon final passing thereof.

Read three times by unanimous vote, and passed by the Council of
the Town of Blaine Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, this
13th day of July, A.D. 1971.
