A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING OF OCCUPANTS OF TRAILERS AND PORTABLE SHACKS

The Council of the Town of Blaine Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. Every occupant of a trailer or portable shack used for residential purposes within the confines of this Town shall within five days after the expiration of thirty days from the date of entry into the Town of Blaine Lake register such trailer or portable shack with the Town Administrator of the Town of Blaine Lake and obtain a License.
- 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1, where the trailer or portable shack is parked in a trailer park or camp licensed by this Town, the occupant of such trailer or portable shack shall register the same with the owner operator of such park or camp and pay to him the prescribed fee for a license.
- 3. The schedule of fees for a license shall be based on the floor area of the trailer or portable shack based on outside dimensions and shall be as follows:-

- 4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provision of this bylaw shall be subject to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the Town of Blaine Lake. This
