

BYLAW NO. 1/80

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BLAINE LAKE, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT RESPECTING THE JOINT FUNDING OF CERTAIN RECREATION FACILITIES.

The Council of the Town of Blaine Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Town of Blaine Lake, is hereby authorized to enter into the agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, and identified as Exhibit A, with the Rural Municipality of Blaine Lake No. 434 for the purposes stated within the agreement.
2. The Mayor and Town Administrator of the Town of Blaine Lake are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached agreement identified as Exhibit A.
3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect this 8th day of January, 1980.

Memorandum of Agreement made this 21st day of August 1980 A.D.

Between: The Town of Blaine Lake,
BLAINE LAKE, Saskatchewan

and

The Rural Municipality of Blaine Lake No. 434,
BLAINE LAKE, Saskatchewan

This Agreement Witnesseth As Follows:

1. The parties to this agreement agree to provide financial contributions in the amounts further provided in this agreement towards the costs of operating the recreational facilities also further mentioned in this agreement.

2. The parties to this agreement agree that the amounts referred to in 1. above shall be as follows:

TOWN OF BLAINE LAKE \$1,575.00

R.M. OF BLAINE LAKE \$1,500.00

3. The parties to this agreement agree that the amounts payable by the Town of Blaine Lake and the Rural Municipality of Blaine Lake No. 434 shall be paid to the following designated recreational facilities on or before the 31st day of December in each year:

- (1) Blaine Lake Co-op Rink Association
- (2) Blaine Lake Sports Grounds
- (3) Blaine Lake Curling Rink
- (4) Blaine Lake Senior Citizen's Centre
- (5) Blaine Lake Library
- (6) Redberry Park
- (7) Martins Lake Park
- (8) Celebrate Saskatchewan Committee
- (9) Tennis Court

4. The recreational facility receiving the funds hereby agrees to provide to the Town of Blaine Lake and for the Rural Municipality of Blaine Lake No. 434 such documentation and accounting necessary under the Inter-Municipal Recreation facilities mentioned within this agreement, such documentation to be provided on or before the 31st day of January, in the year following the expenditure of such funds.

5. The Town of Blaine Lake and the Rural Municipality of Blaine Lake No. 434 agree that the recreational facilities mentioned in this agreement will be available for all residents of each municipality on an equal opportunity basis.

6. It is understood and agreed that this agreement shall be continuous, but the agreement may be terminated by either party to the agreement giving 30 days notice in writing.

7. This agreement shall be effective January 1, 1980.
