

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BLAINE LAKE  
IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN  
BEING A BYLAW TO ALLOW ALL STORES TO BE  
OPEN ON ALL HOLIDAYS

The Council of the Town of Blaine Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting enacts as follows:

INTERPRETATION

1. In this Bylaw, the word "Holiday" means:

New Year's Day, Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Victoria Day, Canada Day, the first Monday in August, Labour Day, Thanksgiving Day, Remembrance Day, Christmas Day and any day or part of a day:

- i) prescribed as a holiday by any Act other than The Urban Municipality Act, 1984 or an Act of the Parliament of Canada;
- ii) declared as a holiday by the Lieutenant Governor in Council;
- iii) proclaimed as a civic holiday pursuant to section 179 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984.

2. This Bylaw shall allow all stores to be open on all holidays.

3. This Bylaw shall come into effect on the third and final reading.
