BYLAW NO. 4/90

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BLAINE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN BEING A BYLAW TO ALLOW ALL STORES TO BE OPEN ON ALL HOLIDAYS

The Council of the Town of Blaine Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting enacts as follows:

INTERPRETATION

1. In this Bylaw, the word "Holiday" means:

New Year's Day, Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Victoria Day, Canada Day, the first Monday in August, Labour Day, Thanksgiving Day, Remembrance Day, Christmas Day and any day or part of a day:

- i) prescribed as a holiday by any Act other than The Urban Municipality Act, 1984 or an Act of the Parliament of Canada;
- ii) declared as a holiday by the Lieutenant Governor in Council;
- iii) proclaimed as a civic holiday pursuant to section 179 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984.
- This Bylaw shall allow all stores to be open on all holidays.
- This Bylaw shall come into effect on the third and final reading.
