

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BLAINE LAKE
IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO DESIGNATE
THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE DOUKHOBOR PRAYER HOME
AT BLAINE LAKE, SASKATCHEWAN AS BEING A SITE OF
ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE

WHEREAS part 111 of The Heritage Property Act authorizes the council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural, historical or natural value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Blaine Lake has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as The Doukhobor Prayer Home at 318 Main Street a Notice of Intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least seven (7) days prior to the date of that consideration; and

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Administrator of the Municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Blaine Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as The Doukhobor Prayer Home at 318 Main Street and legally described as:

Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4

Block 5

Blaine Lake, Saskatchewan

Plan M 4996

MINERALS IN THE CROWN

The significance of the site is as follows:

- a) The Prayer Home is one of a kind in the Province of Saskatchewan and is an excellent example of the architectural style common to its time.
- b) The home was built in 1931 and still serves a wide area both rural and urban.

- 2. The town administrator is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.
- 3. The town administrator is hereby authorized to cause of copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister and to cause notice of the passing of this bylaw.
- 4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
