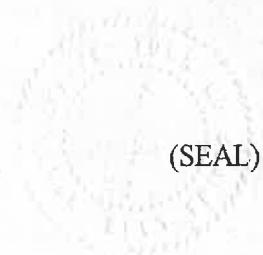
BYLAW NO. 15/97

A Bylaw Of The Town Of Blaine Lake, In The Province Of Saskatchewan To Enter Into An Agreement With The Rural Municipality Of Blaine Lake No. 434 For The Purpose Of Establishing A Sign Corridor.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to enter into an agreement with the Rural Municipality of Blaine Lake No. 434 for the purpose of establishing a sign corridor for use by the Town and Rural businesses;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Blaine Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The agreement attached hereto and marked "A" shall take effect in all respects as Schedule "A" to Bylaw No. 15/97.
2. The Mayor and Administrator are hereby authorized, empowered and directed, to execute the agreement incorporated herewith as Schedule "A" to this bylaw and forming part thereof, and to affix the corporate seal of the Town of Blaine Lake and to do and to cause to be done all acts, matters and things which may be necessary for the due performance and fulfillment of the said agreement.
3. Bylaws No. 13/97 and No. 3/96 are hereby repealed.
4. The bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of final passing thereof.
