

Bylaw No. 9/98

**A Bylaw of the Town of Blaine Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan
to Provide for Penalties for Contravention of Bylaws.**

The Council of the Town of Blaine Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan in open meeting enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
2. Section 3 and 4 of this bylaw applies only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided for.
3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of *The Urban Municipality Act*, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000 and costs for every offence.
4. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of *The Urban Municipality Act*, shall be liable to a fine on not more than \$5,000 and costs for every offence.
5. Bylaw No. 115/74 is hereby repealed.
