## Bylaw No. 9/98

## A Bylaw of the Town of Blaine Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan to Provide for Penalties for Contravention of Bylaws.

The Council of the Town of Blaine Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan in open meeting enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
- 2. Section 3 and 4 of this bylaw applies only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided for.
- 3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of *The Urban Municipality Act*, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000 and costs for every offence.
- 4. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of *The Urban Municipality Act*, shall be liable to a fine on not more than \$5,000 and costs for every offence.

5. Bylaw No. 115/74 is hereby repealed.
