

BYLAW NO. 3 / 2001

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BLAINE LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN BEING A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF SCRAP TIRES IN THE TOWN LANDFILL SITE.

The Council of the Town of Blaine Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting hereby enacts as follows:

1. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires in the municipal owned landfill located in the R.M. of Blaine Lake No. 434 on land legally described as

“All that portion of the South West Quarter (SW1/4), of Section Thirty-one (31), in Township Forty-four (44), in Range Six (6), West of the Third (3rd) Meridian, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, containing 14.39 acres, more or less, shown as Parcel “A”, on a Plan of Record in the Land Titles Office for the Prince Albert Land Registration District as No. B.I. 1817.

Excepting: 0.02 of an acre, more or less, shown as Parcel “Y” taken for Roadway, as shown on a Plan of Record in the said Land Titles Office as No. 61PA00294.

MINERALS IN THE CROWN”.

2. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires on any other municipal property unless specifically designated as a tire marshalling yard.
3. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to a fine of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars.
