## Town of Blaine Lake Bylaw No. 2009-08

A Bylaw of the Town of Blaine Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan to enter into an Agreement with AKB Holdings of Blaine Lake for the purpose of establishing a Sign Corridor.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to enter into an agreement with AKB Holdings for the purpose of establishing a sign Corridor for use by the Town and Rural businesses;
