Town of Blaine Lake Bylaw No. 2016-08

A Bylaw of the Town of Blaine Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan to establish fire fighting services and fees.

The Council of the Town of Blaine Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting hereby enacts as follows:

- The Town of Blaine Lake is hereby authorized to provide fire-fighting service, 1. and to establish fees for providing such service.
- 2. The previously established "Blaine Lake Volunteer Fire Department" is hereby authorized to provide these fire fighting services.
- 3. The cost of the fire fighting services provided within the Town of Blaine Lake shall be charged directly on the ratepayers who receive the service in accordance with Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
- Any unpaid amounts owing to the Town of Blaine Lake for the costs charged as 4. per Section "3" of this bylaw, may be added to the tax roll of the parcel(s) where the fire fighting service was provided.
- 5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on January 1, 2017.

SCHEDULE "A"

Bylaw 2016-08 Town of Blaine Lake

Fees to be charged for fire fighting services within the Town of Blaine Lake:

- 1. Fire truck \$400.00/truck for the first hour or any part thereof within a minimum charge of 1 hour. \$150.00/truck/hour for each additional hour or any part thereof.
- 2. Fire fighters \$20.00/man/hour or any part thereof with a minimum charge of 1 man hour per man.
- 3. Fire Chief \$25.00/hour or any part thereof with a minimum charge of 1 hour.
- 4. Any supplies or additional equipment used to fight fire will be billed at cost.
