Town of Blaine Lake Bylaw No. 2017-04

A Bylaw of the Town of Blaine Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan to establish a fee to appeal assessments.

The Council of the Town of Blaine Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting hereby enacts as follows:

This bylaw may be referred to as "The Assessment Appeal Fee Bylaw"

- 1, The following definitions shall apply to this Bylaw:
 - a) Act: means "The Municipalities Act";
 - b) **Board**: means the Board of Revision established or appointed by the Municipality;

- c) Municipality: means the Town of Blaine Lake.
- d) Secretary: means the Secretary to the Board of Revision.
- A person desiring to appeal their assessment to the Board shall file their appeal
 in the form prescribed in the Act on or before the last date on which appeals can
 be lodged as indicated
 - a) within the notice required by Section 217 of the Act
 - b) on the notice of assessment required by Sections 215 and 219 of the Act.
- 3. A fee of \$200.00 per appeal is hereby established for the purpose of filing an appeal to the Board.
- 4. The applicable fee shall be payable to the Town of Blaine Lake and may be paid at the time of filing the appeal and in any event no later than the final date for lodging an appeal with the Board.
- 5. Where the appellant fails to pay the applicable fee pursuant to Section 3 & 4 of this bylaw, the appeal is deemed to be dismissed.
- 6. The Town of Blaine Lake shall refund any fee that was submitted by the appellant if:
 - a) the appeal is not filed by the Secretary of the Board;
 - b) the appeal is withdrawn in accordance with Section 227 of the Act; or
 - c) an agreement is entered into pursuant to Section 228 of the Act.
- 7. A fee of \$25.00 per appeal is hereby established for any person who wishes to obtain copies of the Board's decision and other documents. This feel is payable to the Town of Blaine Lake.
- 8. Bylaw 4/997 is hereby repealed.
