

**Town of Blaine Lake  
Bylaw No. 2021-003**

A Bylaw of the Town of Blaine Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan to establish waste and recycling collection fees.

The Council of the Town of Blaine Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting hereby enacts as follows:

1. All residential properties using water and/or sewer services provided by the Town of Blaine Lake, shall also be required to use the waste and recycling collection services provided by the municipality. Any other properties may also use such services upon request.
2. The fees for providing residential waste and recycling collection shall be \$54 bi-monthly plus a \$3.00 bi-monthly infrastructure fee making the total residential waste & recycling fee of \$57.00 bi-monthly.
3. The fee for providing commercial waste and recycling collection shall be the fee charges for the service by 16-43 Waste Management Corp. plus, a \$5.00/bi-monthly administration fee and a \$2.00/bi-monthly infrastructure fee.
4. Charges shall be billed to the premise owner bi-monthly, along with water/sewer billings.
5. Payment of water, sewer and waste and recycling collection fees shall be applied proportionately to the three categories.
6. Charges due over 30 days shall be charged at a rate of five percent of the outstanding balance per year.
7. Any charges and accrued interest that remains unpaid on December 31st of the year in which they were payable by bona fide owners shall be added to and thereby form part of the taxes on the land with respect to which the charges were made.
8. If waste and recycling collection services have been discontinued from any premises for non-payment of a waste collection bill, or for any other reason, that same premise shall not be supplied with waste collection until all penalties, fees and arrears, if any, have been paid.
9. The fees may be amended from time to time, in order to reflect any increase in fees by 16-43 Waste Management Corporation.
10. The owner will be provided with one waste and one recycling bin. Any damage occurring or replacement of bin will be charged to the owner.
11. The schedule of rates above shall come into force and take effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of September 2021 and remain in effect until amended or revised by bylaw.
12. Bylaw No. 2019-03. is hereby repealed.
