The Sarcan bottle depot hours are Monday to Friday 10:00 am to 12:00 noon and 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm all year.

Reminder from Loraas Disposal Services Ltd.

Do's:

- Have the cart curbside by 7:00 am on collection day
- Keep the lid closed
- Bag all trash and place inside the cart; bagged or unbagged trash left beside the cart will NOT be collected
- Cut and bundle, or bag garden debris and place in cart

Don't:

- Overfill the cart, keep lid closed (overloaded carts will NOT be collected.)
- Pack trash too tightly
- Paint or write on cart
- Remove cart from your residence.

Items Not Allowed In or Near Carts:

- Hazardous or regulated waste including paint, solvents, tires, chemicals, oil, oil filters, batteries, etc.
- Sod, dirt or concrete
- Ashes of any description
- Construction or demolition materials including: boards, roofing material, carpet, etc.
- Automotive parts oil, oil filters, etc.
- Tree clippings over 2' in length
- Liquids of any kind
- Animals or animal parts
