Public Hearing for Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw

There will be a Public Hearing at 1:00 pm on Monday, August 15th, 2011 in Council Chambers. Council will also consider written comments received at the hearing or delivered to the Town Office prior to the hearing. Copies of the proposed bylaws can be obtained at the Town Office at a cost of \$5.00/bylaw.

Grass/Weed Cutting done by Town Employees

Anyone who allows the grass or weeds to become overgrown and unsightly (longer than 20 cm) on their property and that Town Employees have to cut will be charged \$100.00 per lot. If they do not pay the bill, it will be added to their property taxes.
