FREE GARBAGE DAY - SATURDAY, MAY 21st

From 10:00 am to 12:00 noon and 1:00 to 4:00 pm on Saturday, May 21st. Each household is permitted to haul 1 free half-ton load of garbage to the transfer station, after that, regular rates apply.

Open Air Fires in Town

The only burning that is permitted in Town must be done in a non-combustible receptacle constructed of cement, brick or sheet metal with a minimum 18-gauge thickness and it must be covered with a heavy gauge screen with openings not to exceed 13 mm. The only thing that can be burnt in the fire pit is **seasoned wood or charcoal**. Fires must be supervised, properly ventilated, and the smoke from the fire must not interfere with another person's use and enjoyment of their property.
