Change in household waste collection fees

On this month's utility bill you will notice that waste collection fees have gone up slightly. Residential waste collection has gone to \$10.50/month from \$9.95/month. Commercial bins have also increased depending on the size of bin used in your location. This increase has come about because Loraas Disposal has increased the rates charged to the Town for waste collection.

Landfill Hours

Effective October 1^{st} , the landfill will change to it's winter hours - Wednesdays & Saturdays 10 am to noon & 1 - 4 pm.

Compostable material (grass, leaves, garden refuse, etc.) can be taken to the Landfill on regular landfill days for free.
