Blaine Lake Seniors

Deadline to Pay Property Taxes

2012 Property taxes must be paid not later than December 31st, 2012 to avoid having a 10% penalty added to them. Payments can be made at the Town Office, on-line, or at several banking institutions. For your convenience we will accept cheques that are post-dated to December 31st, 2012. If you are mailing your payment, the envelope must be post marked no later than December 31st, 2012. ***The Town office will be closing at 12:00 noon on Monday, December 31st , 2012***.

Annual Water Billings

The option of being billed annually for water, sewer and waste disposal service is available to all local residents. People choosing to pay this way are billed for the entire year in January and are given a 5% discount. The only time a person would receive a bill or need to pay more than this is when their quarterly consumption exceeds the maximum usage of 9900 gallons per quarter, and then they are just billed for the overage. This year the annual billing will be \$674.70 (including the discount).

Any resident, who is not already being billed annually but is interested in being billed for water, sewer and garbage on an annual basis (once per year) can contact the Town office for more information.

2013 Water, Sewer & Waste Rate Increase

Effective January 1, 2013, water, sewer and waste rates will be increasing. Water will be \$34.50 per month for the first 3300 gallons and 1.05 per every 100 gallons used over the 3300 gallons. Sewer will be \$11.00 per month and waste will be \$13.00 per month.

Pet Owners

2013 dog licenses are due in January. License rates are: \$10.00 each for spayed or neutered non-restricted dogs; \$25.00 if it's a non-restricted dog; and \$55.00 for a restricted dog. Help us help you to locate your lost pet!
