## SPRING/SUMMER LANDFILL HOURS

The Landfill has started summer hours effective April 1<sup>st</sup>/12 to September 30/12.

Tuesdays – 3:00 – 8:00 p.m.

Wednesdays – 10:00 am – 12:00 noon and 1:00 – 4:00 p.m.

Saturdays - 10:00 am – 12:00 noon and 1:00 – 4:00 p.m.

#### **SCOOP THE POOP**

Pet waste can be smelly, unattractive, and can even be a health issue for you and your pet. Carry a bag with you to pick-up your pet's poop whenever you are off your property. Poop can be collected in a plastic bag and thrown in the garbage.

You do not need to clean up waste immediately on your private property, but you still need to clean it up regularly. Allowing excessive waste to build up affects your neighbours and pet negatively.

## **Flatten Cardboard Boxes**

Please remember to flatten cardboard boxes before putting them into the recycle bins. By flattening the cardboard we can put twice as much material into the recycle bins. The Town must pay Loraas Disposal to come out and empty the bin. If we don't flatten the boxes it defeats the purpose of recycling because the Loraas Disposal truck has to come out when the bin is only half full to empty it!

## **Enforcement of the "Nuisance Bylaw"**

A reminder to all residents that the Town is actively enforcing our "Nuisance Bylaw" again this year. We will be sending notices to any residents who allow grass/weeds on their property to become "overgrown" (a height of over 20 cm); or have "junked vehicles" stored on their property; or whose property is deemed untidy or unsightly due to the accumulation of lumber, cardboard, paper, newspaper, appliances, tires, cans, barrels, scrap metal or other waste materials or junk. If the property owner does not remedy the situation within a specified time from the Town will do the clean-up work and add the cost of doing the work to the owner's property tax.

## Open Air Fires in Town

The only burning that is permitted in Town must be done in a non-combustible receptacle constructed of cement, brick or sheet metal with a minimum 18-gauge thickness and it must be covered with a heavy gauge screen with openings not to exceed 13 mm. The only think that can be burnt in the fire pit is **seasoned wood or charcoal**. Fires must be supervised, properly ventilated, and the smoke from the fire must not interfere with another person's use and enjoyment of their property.

# **GOLF COURSE**

#### **LANDFILL**

It is unlawful to dispose of hazardous materials in your garbage bin or at the landfill. Please do not put any waste in bags marked BIOHAZARD WASTE as Loraas charges the Town of Blaine Lake for improper disposal of these bags.
