#### **DEADLINE TO PAY PROPERTY TAXES**

2012 Property taxes were to be paid no later than December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012 to avoid having a 10% penalty added to them. If you have not already done so, payments can be made at the Town Office, on-line, or at several banking institutions.

#### **Annual Water Billings**

The option of being billed annually for water, sewer and waste disposal service is available to all local residents. People choosing to pay this way are billed for the entire year in January and are given a 5% discount. The only time a person will receive a bill or need to pay more than this is when their quarterly consumption exceeds the maximum usage of 9900 gallons per quarter, and then they are just billed for the overage. This year the annual billing will be \$674.70 (including the discount).

Any resident, who is not already being billed annually but is interested in being billed for water, sewer and garbage on an annual basis (once per year) can contact the Town office for more information.

## 2013 Water, Sewer & Waste Rate Increase

Effective January 1, 2013, water, sewer and waste rates have increased. Water is \$34.50 per month for the first 3300 gallons and 1.05 per every 100 gallons used over the 3300 gallons. Sewer is \$11.00 per month and waste will be \$13.00 per month.

### **Pet Owners**



2013 dog & cat licenses are now due. License rates are \$10.00 each for spayed or neutered non-restricted dogs & cats; \$25.00 if it's a non-restricted dog or cat; and \$55.00 for a restricted dog. Licensing your pet benefits

both the town and the pet owner, please be a responsible pet owner and ensure your pets are licensed!

We also would like to remind you that The Town of Blaine Lake has a bylaw stating dogs and cats are not permitted to run at large and to help keep our town clean and safe by cleaning up after your dogs while out of your walks.

<u>Snow Removal</u> – As the snow continues to fall this winter, please remember to keep your vehicles off the street when the need for snow clearing is evident.
