Contractor would also supply all personnel, tools, eg; rakes, shovels, grass, weed mowers to complete any or all clean up. Any articles that are removed from any site would have to be disposed at the appropriate waste management site and would not be deemed to be salvage. Any application from anv contractor/person should state the cost/rates of any work done to completion using an acceptable invoice and/or form that outlines those rates.
