Preparing for Spring Run Off

With the amount of snow that has fallen this winter, removing all the snow accumulation has certainly been a challenge. In the last couple of weeks, the Town has been removing snow from the streets to lessen spring runoff, to accommodate proper drainage and to help prevent flooding.

Snow removal will be ongoing. There are steps homeowners can take to protect their property from flooding due to melting snow: (Some of the following tips involve snow shoveling which is heavy work. Consider doing a bit at a time and please use care and caution. Get help if you have health concerns.)

Clear snow away from basement window wells and your home's foundation.

- Check your roof and eavestroughs (gutters) for excess snow. Consider hiring someone to clear snow from your roof if you are unable to do it yourself. A roof rake may help to clear the snow and debris from the edge of your roof.
- Water should be drained at least 6 feet away from outside walls and ensure that it flows away from the house.
- Ice ridges and snow build-up on the ground that is stopping water from draining onto the street should be removed.
- If you don't have a sump pump already, you might want to purchase one. If you already have a sump pump, check it over and make sure it is working properly.
- Most lots drain along the outside edges. Remove snow from these areas.

Please be considerate of your neighbours and prevent water from your property draining onto their property.

PROPERTY OWNERS ARE REMINDED IT IS UNLAWFUL TO CLEAR SNOW FROM THEIR YARDS AND ADD IT TO THE STREETS OR PLACE IT ON ANOTHER PROPERTY THAT IS NOT THEIR OWN.
