During routine water line maintenance the Town experienced a couple of water line breaks. Although it is unlikely that any bacteria entered the water lines, as a precaution, the Town has issued a **“Boil Water Advisory” and a Restriction on Water Usage**. These measures will ensure the safety of our water supply and ensure that water is available if an emergency situation should arise.
