Dog/Cat Licenses

2014 Pet licenses were due February 28th, 2014 Resident's with cats or dogs are encouraged to purchase their pet licenses as soon as possible. Ron Klassen, our Bylaw Enforcement Officer will be ensuring that all pets in the Town are licensed. Owners of pets that are not licensed will be fined \$40.00 in addition to the license fee.

Pet Owners are now able to purchase a license for their dog or cat that is good for the lifetime of their pet. The lifetime license fee for a spayed or neutered dog or cat is \$50.00; or for an unaltered dog or cat is \$100.00. Permanent, lifetime, pet licenses will not be issued to a restricted dog. This license is not transferable to another pet and once purchased no refunds would be made to the purchaser regardless of the circumstances.




Curbside Recycling


