### "2016 Residential Water, Sewer & Waste Rates

Water rates will remain at \$34.50 per month for the first 3300 gallons and 1.05 per every 100 gallons used over the 3300 gallons. Sewer will be \$12.00 per month; waste and recycling will be \$20.35 per month and the infrastructure fee will be \$12.00 per month. Total minimum monthly bill will be \$78.85.

## Annual Water Billings

The option of being billed annually for water, sewer and waste disposal service is available to all local residents. People choosing to pay this way are billed for the entire year in January and given a 5% discount. The only time a person would receive a bill or need to pay more than this is when their quarterly consumption exceeds the maximum usage of 9900 gallons per quarter, and then they are just billed for the overage. This year the annual billing will be \$911.00. (including the discount).

Any resident, who is not already being billed annually but is interested in being billed for water, sewer and garbage on an annual basis (once per year) can contact the Town Office for more information.

### **Dog/Cat Licenses**

2016 Pet licenses are due in January. License rates are: \$15.00 for spayed or neutered non-restricted dog or cat; \$30.00 for non-restricted dog or cats that are not spayed or neutered; and \$60.00 for a restricted dog. Licenses must be renewed by February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2016. After that date, the Bylaw Enforcement Officer will be ensuring that all pets in the Town are licensed and the owners of pets that are not licensed will be fined \$40.00 in addition to the license fee.

### Lifetime Dog/Cat Licenses

Pet Owners are now able to purchase a license for their dog or cat that is good for the lifetime of their pet. The lifetime license fee for a spayed or neutered dog or cat is \$50.00; or for an unaltered dog or cat is \$100.00. Permanent, lifetime, pet licenses will not be issued to a restricted dog.

This license is not transferable to another pet and once purchased no refunds would be made to the purchaser regardless of the circumstances.
