DEVOPMENT OF REGIONAL WASTE SITE

The Town of Blaine Lake together with 6 other Towns/villages and R.M.'s are in the process of developing a Regional Waste facility. The Regional Waste site will be located just off of Highway 40 West of Hafford (where the hog barns used to be located). The site will be set up to handle garbage and recycling as well as eliminate the need to haul garbage and recycling to Loraas Disposal in Saskatoon.

We will continue to have door-to-door pick up and our transfer station that is located just outside of Town will remain.

Being part of this Regional Waste group will not eliminate the cost of managing our waste and recycling, however we will have more control over the cost. It is anticipated that this site will be up and running by 2017.

Open Air Fires in Town

The only burning that is permitted in Town must be done in a non-combustible receptacle constructed of cement, brick or sheet metal with a minimum 18-gauge thickness and it must be covered with a heavy gauge screen with openings not to exceed 13 mm. The only thing that can be burnt in the fire pit is seasoned wood or charcoal. Fires must be supervised, properly ventilated, and the smoke from the fire must not interfere with another person's use and enjoyment of their property.





CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PETS

Residents are reminded that all dogs or cats must be licensed, and kept on a leash when not on their owner's property. If a dog or cat defecates (poops) on any public or private property other than the property of the owner, the owner is responsible to immediately remove and dispose of the feces in a sanitary manner. Pet owners must also remove animal feces from their own property in a prompt and sanitary manner. Thank you for your cooperation.
