NOTICE

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the **Town of Blaine Lake** intends to adopt a bylaw under *The Planning and Development Act, 2007* to amend Bylaw No. 2013-05, known as the *Zoning Bylaw*.

INTENT

The proposed bylaw amendment will allow small ground signs to be located on public sidewalks and for the installation of free standing electronic variable message signs.

AFFECTED LANDS

Properties situated in Town Centre Commercial District (C1); Highway Commercial Districts (C2); General Industrial Districts (I1) and Community Service Districts (CS) zoning areas.

REASON

The reason for the amendment is to establish regulations for small ground signs and free standing electronic variable message signs.

PUBLIC INSPECTION

The Bylaw may be inspected by any person at the Town Office during regular office hours from 8:00 a.m. to 12 Noon and 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday excluding Statutory holidays. Copies are available at cost.

PUBLIC HEARING

Council will be holding a public hearing on Friday, May 19th, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Office to receive submissions about the proposed bylaw. Interested persons or groups may appear before Council at that time to make representations on this amendment.

FULL –TIME SUMMER STUDENT EMPLOYMENT

The Position:

The Town of Blaine Lake invites applications for a summer student.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be at least 16 years old, and have attended school in 2016-17 and must be returning to either High School or to a post secondary institution in the fall. A Driver's License is an asset.

Dates and Salary:
