FREE LANDFILL DAY
SATURDAY, MAY 23, 2020
10AM to Noon and 1pm to 4PM

Again, this year, the Town will be holding a “Free Landfill Day” This is a great opportunity for residents to clean up lots and to clear out those unwanted items from their home and garages.

There are just a few rules and regulations to keep in mind:

- Only one ½ ton load per household will be accepted.
Anyone hauling more than 1 load is considered a contractor. (If they are hauling waste for their neighbour they have to pay).
- Regular fees will apply for large furniture – eg. Couches, mattresses. Chairs will be accepted for free.
- Regular fees will apply for any appliance that has freon - eg fridges, freezers, air conditioners.

We will only be able to accept waste until the 2 bins are full. Please, do not place any garbage or waste on the ground or ramps. All household waste must be placed in the bins.

ALSO: When visiting the transfer station please do not go in and COLLECT items.


PLEASE NOTE
