Garden Refuse can be hauled to the Transfer Station for FREE when it is open.

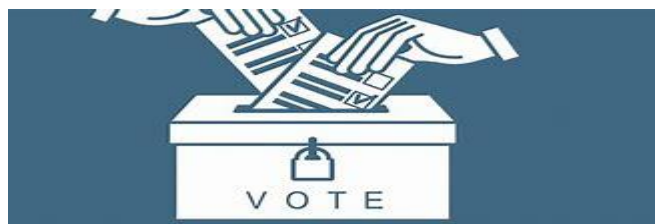

Bylaw Enforcement Update

This summer, our Bylaw Enforcement Officer Judy McHarg was very busy addressing bylaw infractions within the community. Lots untidy with weeds, long grass or overgrown trees were addressed, as were, vehicles and trailers parked on streets and alleys for extended period of times.

Officer Judy will continue to be a presence in our Community and some of the bylaw infractions that she will be addressing;

Traffic Control Bylaw No: 2013-08

- Vehicles parked on streets in excess of 72 hours
 - Vehicles parked on streets which are unlicensed, inoperable, being repaired etc
 - Trailers or semi-trailers – unattached – parked on alley ways, streets or boulevards
 - Recreational vehicles parked on streets or boulevards in excess of 72 hours ie: trailers, boats – attached or unattached to vehicles.
- Animal Control Bylaw No: 2004-9
 - Pets Running at Large
- Unregistered Pets – as of February 1st of each year
 - Excessive barking
- Restricted Dogs – registration and insurance requirements

Council wishes to thank everyone for their cooperation with Officer Judy in resolving non-compliance issues – our Town looks better for it. The above bylaws can be found on the Town website www.blainelake.ca and please contact the Town office with any questions.
