Open Air Fires in Town

The only burning that is permitted in Town must be done in a non-combustible receptacle constructed of cement, brick or sheet metal with a minimum 18-gauge thickness and it must be covered with a heavy gauge screen with openings not to exceed 13 mm. The only thing that can be burnt in the fire pit is seasoned wood or charcoal. Fires must be supervised, properly ventilated, and the smoke from the fire must not interfere with another person's use and enjoyment of their property.



UNTIDY YARDS

The Bylaw Officer has been driving around our Town and there are some Homeowners/Renters that are getting Warning Letters and/or Fines for Overgrown Grass & Weeds. If your property is not cleaned up by the date on your Notice then the Town will go in and clean it up and add the fee to the Taxes. We strongly recommend that you have someone maintain your yard as the Town does not want to make a habit of cleaning yards.

WATER TREATMENT PLANT UPDATE

In August 2021, the Town of Blaine Lake expects to put into operation its Reverse Osmosis System which will supply quality treated water to its residents.

With this new system, will come a new billing charge on all water bills. A WTP Capital Asset Fee of \$75.00 will be stated on water bills received in September (July-August service period). As well, the sewer rate will be charged as a percentage of usage rather than a flat rate. On usage that does not exceed the minimum, the cost is \$24.50 (35% of \$70.00), however, where usage exceeds the minimum, the sewer rate will be calculated on a percentage basis.

The following rates have been approved by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board and took effect on July 1, 2021. The full bylaw can be reviewed on the Town website www.blainelake.ca
