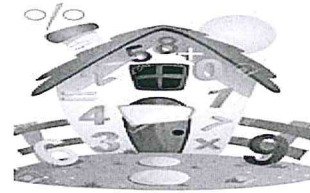
Town Council Meetings

Please call the Town Office first if you are interested in attending due to social distancing.

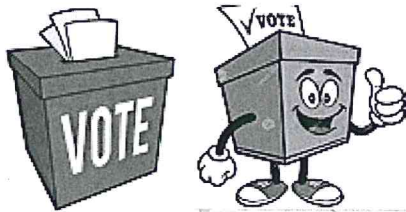

YOUR HOME.**



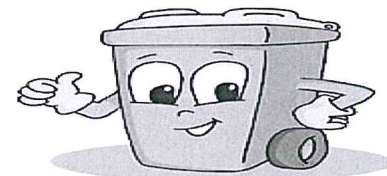
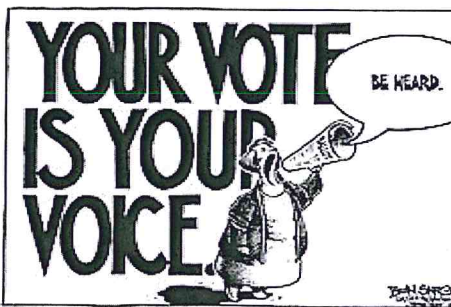
