Again this year the Town will be holding a "Free Landfill Day". This is a great opportunity for residents to clean up lots and to clear out those unwanted items from their homes and garages. There are just a few rules and regulations to keep in mind:

- Only one ½ ton load per household will be accepted – anyone hauling more than 1 load is considered a contractor. (If they are hauling waste for their neighbor they have to pay).
- Regular fees will apply for large furniture eg. Couches, Mattresses. Chairs will be accepted for FREE.

- Regular fees will apply for any appliance that has Freon-eg: Fridges, Freezers, Air Conditioners.
- We will only be able to accept waste until the 2 bins are full.
- No waste is to be placed on the ground or ramps. All household waste must be put in the bins!




Located on the west side of the Town, there are BBQ stands, washrooms, a children's playground and a Par 3 Golf Course.


