RE: Rescinding of Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory

This letter is to advise that the Water Security Agency (WSA) in consultation with the Saskatchewan Health Authority Prince Albert Office, has by way of this letter rescinded the Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory (PDWA), issued to the Town of Blaine Lake on **February 26, 2021, effective immediately this Wednesday March 3, 2021**. This advisory has been rescinded after consecutive sets of samples obtained from the distribution system have returned acceptable results and the system has been flushed.

I would advise the Town to issue immediate notice to the public of the rescinding of the advisory. Further, the Town may return to its regular sampling intervals. If a positive sample is realized upon immediate return to regular sampling submission, the Water Security Agency may, if believed necessary, consider the issuance of a new PDWA.
