STRATEGIC PLAN UPDATES FROM THE CAO:



The Joint Working Group established with Muskeg Lake Cree Nation is collaborating to:

- Oversee implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding.
- Identify, evaluate, and recommend joint projects or initiatives.
- Coordinate communications and seek community engagement, guidance and advise.
- Monitor progress and report to both Councils.

The First meeting will be held in January 2026. The initial priority areas for collaboration are:

- **Health Care** – identify projects to entice health care professionals to locate to the area;
- **Housing** – identify projects that can aid in servicing and construction of lands held with the Town or on reserve;
- **Economic and Business Development** – identify businesses and services that would be beneficial to the communities.

Council and staff have reviewed the 2026 Budget and will provide further information in future newsletters and press releases.

A new cutting-edge website will be created in 2026.

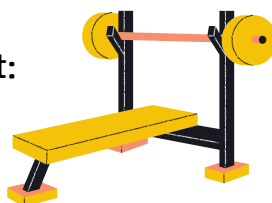
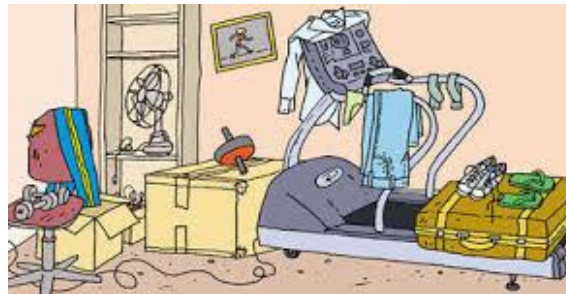
Do You Want to see Blaine Lake Thrive?

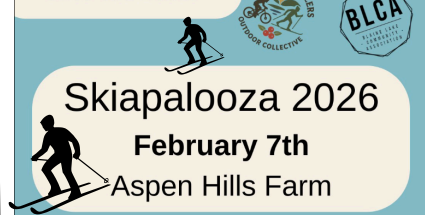
