Strategic Plan Updates from the CAO

The roads are busy with harvest activity as we shift into September. The months of July and August have been busy ones shifting into the role of Administrator and managing ongoing projects. We have advertised for the position of Town Foreman and will be actively accepting applications until the position is filled. Please see the town website or Facebook page for application details. The correct names of our new Community Safety Officers are Brad Pechawis and Steve Sabados. You may have seen them around town last month.

Otherwise, these are some noteworthy updates for this month:

Playground Safety

Town council approved the cost for fence installation at the Lodge park earlier this year and it was installed the week of August 24-25, 2026. The goal is to separate the park from the lodge to encourage children to play in the designated area. We will be enforcing illegal parking bylaws on town property in this area and around town, see bylaw 04/2020. We hope that this fenced area will improve safety for children and residents who frequent the park. Thank you to Town public works for the quick installation.

Dust Control

For the areas of town that did not receive SB-90 application this year, the town applied the remaining calcium chloride in this year's dust control budget to the gravel streets and avenues. The grader has made additional passes on SB-90 avenues this month, which appears to have helped with the hardening process. The town is in continued discussions with Sands Dust Control to reach an amicable final product. We appreciate everyone's patience with this year's dust control project and will keep you updated on any upcoming plans to extend the dust control in the future.

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New Website

The new website has been under construction with Catalis for several weeks. Town Administrative Staff has received training to operate the back end of the new website so that we're able to make updates to content and information in-house. Some major benefits to our new website are its mobile responsiveness with mass communication features via text, email, phone (including landlines) for important town updates, and, if you have an event you'd like to put on the town events calendar, you can submit it directly on our site for approval. You can expect the new website to be launched in the next 2-3 weeks with ongoing updates. If you don't see anything on the town's event calendar right away, we will be working on getting our events up to date for the fall and winter.

Other items of note:

- Sewer Main Flushing will be taking place during the first week of September on the east side of town.
- Mural Restoration on 1st Avenue East is scheduled to begin September 20th, with the Arena restoration to follow in spring.
- Discussions for development and collaboration continue per our MOU with Muskeg Lake Cree Nation.
- Sidewalk restoration on Main Street is nearly complete, and Public Works did some work filling potholes in the alleys around town.
